

PROPERTY EVALUATION PROGRAM

The Property Evaluation Program's main goal is to expand the state's inventory of both industrial sites and existing buildings through an evaluation of a community's existing inventory that prioritizes where investment may be most beneficial and what steps may be needed to address issues and shortcomings.

Prepared and available industrial properties are essential for a community to be competitive for industrial recruitment. However, developing and maintaining this inventory is difficult and many communities have few quality properties available for the market. This program benefits communities through emphasizing the importance of and assisting with planning for the future. This includes both readying industrial properties for near-term development as well as creating a pipeline of properties for future development.

The Certified Sites program helps communities minimize the risks for private investment and job creation.

Launched in 2012, the program sets rigorous standards to give companies detailed and reliable information during the site selection process. The State of Tennessee utilizes the services of Austin Consulting to ensure sites meet the expectations and needs of both site selectors and companies. TNECD has established a reimbursable grant to assist communities with the preparation of sites. These grants are discretionary and are based on county tax tier.
